Election Petition (L) No. 543 of 2025

Public Notice

Public at large are hereby informed that Mr. Mahesh Vishnupant Kothe who had filed Election Petition Lodg. No. 543 of 2025 before the Hon'ble Bombay High Court challenging election of Vijaykumar Deshmukh from 248 Solapur City, North Assembly Constituency held in November 2024, has passed away on 14th January 2025, at Kumbh Mela at Prayagraj, Uttar Pradesh.
