The seat booking schedule for the month of February 2026 shall be accordingly enabled and the details shall be communicated on the DG Shipping website by the last week of January 2026.

5. No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall before the examination is over.

7. All the candidates will have to maintain discipline inside the examination centre, protect furniture and the IT infrastructure. In case an examinee is found indulging in unfair means during the exam, action shall be taken as per Rule 72 of the MS(STCW) Rules, 2014.
