GUJARAT PRIMARY EDUCATION ACT, 1947.

No. K/SH/2/2026/ED/MIS/e-file/3/2022/4475/CH:- WHEREAS the Government of Gujarat, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of section 3A of the Gujarat Provincial Municipal Corporations Act, 1949 (Bom. LIX of 1949), vide Government Notification, Urban Development and Urban Housing Department No. KV/47 of 2020/AMN/902019/9358/P, dated the 18th June, 2020, extended the boundary of Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation.

AND WHEREAS the District Education Committee, District Panchayat, Ahmedabad has made representation to the State Government to hand over the control and management of Ghuma Primary School, Bopal Primary School, Kathavada Primary School, B.L. Mehta Kathavada Meij Primary School, Zaveri dairy farm Primary School and Hudko Primary School with approved staff to Nagar Primary Education Committee, Municipal Corporation Ahmedabad, vide it's resolution:109, dated the 26th June, 2023 and the District Education Committee, District Panchayat, Gandhinagar has also made representation to the State Government to hand over the control and management of Chiloda baraiya kumar Primary School, Chiloda baraiya kanya Primary School and Gopal Nagar Primary School with approved staff to Nagar Primary Education Committee, Municipal Corporation Ahmedabad, vide it's resolution:81, dated the 4th July, 2022. Thereafter, the Urban Development & Urban Housing Department and the Panchayat, Rural Housing & Rural Development department have given their consent on this department's even number file.

AND WHEREAS the State Government has considered the said representation and decided to hand over the control of above mentioned 09 Primary Schools with approved staff and movable-immovable property to Nagar Primary Education Committee, Municipal Corporation Ahmedabad.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 18A of the Gujarat Primary Education Act, 1947 (Bom. LIX of 1947), the Government of Gujarat is pleased to hand over the control of above mentioned 09 Primary Schools with approved staff and movable-immovable property to Nagar Primary Education Committee, Municipal Corporation, Ahmedabad on the following conditions, namely:-

Conditions:-

1. Nagar Primary Education Committee, Municipal Corporation Ahmedabad will get 80:20% grant as per rules.
2. At present, the teachers of concerned District Education Committee have to give option whether they are willing to be retained or to go to Nagar Primary Education Committee, Ahmedabad. This procedure has to be completed within one month.
3. All the accounts related to GPF, CPF including Service Books along with service records shall be handed over to concerned Nagar Primary Education Committee.
4. Directorate of Primary Education, The District Primary Education Officer Ahmedabad, Gandhinagar and Administrative officer Ahmedabad primary education committee shall fix the date to hand over the control and management of above mentioned 09 Primary Schools.
5. After the fixation of date, all the teachers, educational and administrative responsibilities of students and the movable-immovable properties vest in Nagar Primary Education Committee, Ahmedabad.
6. For the teachers, who opt to be retained under the control of concerned District Education Committee, the orders to accommodate them in the vacant posts of respective subjects/Department, shall immediately be issued. And by this arrangements, the transfer rules of dated; 11/05/2023, No. PRE/11/2012/621065/K(Part-1) will not be affected.
