East.- Thence, the boundary generally runs towards southwest, southeast and south along the western boundary of survey Numbers 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 of No.52, Velayuthampalayam Village and it reaches the junction point of Survey Numbers 8, 10, 11 and 597 of No.52, Velayuthampalayam Village.

South.- Thence, the boundary generally runs towards southwest along the northern boundary of Survey Numbers 11, 12 and 13 of No.52, Velayuthampalayam Village and it reaches the junction point of Survey Numbers 13, 596 and 597 of No.52, Velayuthampalayam Village and Pannamalai reserved forest.

West.- Thence, the boundary runs towards north along the eastern boundary of Pannamalai reserved forest and reaches the starting point.
