In exercise of the powers conferred under sub-section (1) of section 180 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (Central Act 46 of 2023), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby prescribes that any police officer not below the rank of Head Constable may, on the requisition of the Investigating Officer, examine orally any person supposed to be acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case under section 180 of the said Central Act 46 of 2023.
