Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah, chaired a high-level security review meeting in Jammu to review the preparedness of Shri Amarnathji Yatra which is scheduled from 3rd July to 9th August this year.

During the meeting, the Union Home Minister said that the Government under the leadership of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi is committed to making the Yatra of pilgrims safe, smooth and convenient.
