

UPSC ANNOUNCES FINAL RESULT OF CENTRAL ARMED POLICE FORCES (ASSISTANT COMMANDANTS) EXAMINATION, 2024

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Based on the result of written part of the Central Armed Police Forces (Assistant Commandants) Examination, 2024 held by UNION PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION on 4th August, 2024 and the interviews for Personality Test held from 05.05.2025 to 05.06.2025, the following is the list, in order of merit, of candidates who have been recommended for appointment to the posts of Assistant Commandants (Group A) in the Central Armed Police Forces viz. Border Security Force (BSF), Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF), Central Industrial Security Force (CISF), Indo-Tibetan Border Police (ITBP) and Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB).

2. A total number of 459 candidates have been recommended for appointment as per the following break-up:-

2.1 The final selection/appointment of recommended candidates will be subject to final outcome of the Writ Petition (Civil) No. 5877/2022 filed by Diwakar Pande & Ors. Vs. Ministry of Home Affairs & Ors. pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi.

2.2 The final selection/appointment of candidates with Roll Nos. 1106459, 0505271, 0819210, 0831572 and 1201176 will also be subject to final outcome of Writ Petition (Civil) Nos. 8304/2025, 7043/2025, and 7749/2025 pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi.

2.3 Result of 01 candidate has been withheld as per the direction of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi.

3. Appointments to the various services shall be made by the Government according to the number of vacancies available and subject to the candidates fulfilling all the prescribed eligibility conditions/provisions contained in the Rules for the Examination and verifications, wherever due, being completed satisfactorily. Allotment to various services shall be made according to the merit obtained and preference of services given by candidates.
