

PRIME MINISTER OF MAURITIUS CALLS ON THE PRESIDENT

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The Prime Minister of the Republic of Mauritius, Dr. The Hon. Navinchandra Ramgoolam, called on the President of India, Smt Droupadi Murmu, at Rashtrapati Bhavan today (September 16, 2025). The meeting concluded Prime Minister Ramgoolam's State Visit to India from September 9 to 16, during which he visited Mumbai, Varanasi, Ayodhya, and Tirupati.
