Leaders reaffirm commitment to strengthen India-Denmark Green Strategic Partnership

Leaders exchange views on peaceful and early resolution of the conflict in Ukraine

PM Frederiksen expresses support for early conclusion of India- EU FTA

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Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi had a telephonic conversation with Prime Minister of Denmark H.E. Ms. Mette Frederiksen today.

Both leaders reaffirmed their commitment to further strengthen the India-Denmark Green Strategic Partnership across sectors such as trade, investment, innovation, energy, water management, food processing and sustainable development.
