

Ministry of Power to launch Special Campaign 5.0 from 2nd to 31st October 2025 to promote Swachhata and reduce pendency

Preparatory phase of Special Campaign 5.0
underway from 15th to 30th September 2025,
leading to the October drive focused on e-waste
disposal, workspace cleanliness and efficiency

From December 2024 to August 2025, over 24,000
files reviewed, 4,800 plus grievances disposed off,
and 200 cleanliness campaigns conducted by MoP
under special efforts

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In line with the Government's initiative to institutionalize *Swachhata* and minimize pendency in government offices, the Ministry of Power (MoP), along with its Subordinate Offices, Attached Offices, Autonomous Bodies and CPSUs, have been actively participating in the Special Campaigns since the year 2021.

From December 2024 to August 2025, MoP reviewed 24,370 files and weeded out 20,404 files. In addition, 4,881 public grievances and associated 436 appeals, 324 MP and State Government References were disposed off. A total of 200 cleanliness campaigns were also conducted, leading to disposal of scrap material worth ₹483.63 lakh and 43,579 square feet of space freed. These efforts have created a healthier workplace environment, better record management and contributed to better space management and revenue generation.

Preparatory Phase of 'Special Campaign 5.0' has started from 15th September, 2025 and will continue till 30th September, 2025. During the preparatory phase, MoP will identify the pendency in selected parameters, mobilize the ground functionaries, finalize cleanliness campaign sites, review records, undertake space management planning and identify scrap material for disposal. Nodal Officers in the CPSUs and other Organisations of MoP have been nominated. Guidelines of Special Campaign 5.0 along with google sheet have been circulated for uploading the targets in Preparatory phase.

MoP will make relentless efforts to achieve the objectives of 'Special Campaign 5.0' during Implementation Phase starting from 2nd October to 31st October, 2025, with a special focus on disposal of e-waste.

The Special Campaign 5.0 will continue to enhance cleanliness, boost morale, and optimize the working environment across its offices.

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
