

INS SUTLEJ ARRIVES AT PORT LOUIS FOR 18TH JOINT HYDROGRAPHIC SURVEY MISSION IN MAURITIUS

INS Suttlej, a specialised hydrographic survey vessel of the Indian Navy arrived at Port Louis to undertake **18th Joint Hydrographic Survey at Mauritius on 29 Sep 2025.**

This mission is being conducted under the framework of **long standing bilateral MoU on Hydrography** signed during the **14th Joint Committee Meeting on Hydrography** held earlier this year.

The current survey mission will cover an extensive area of **approx 35,000 square nautical miles.** As part of capacity-building efforts, officers from various Mauritian ministries will embark onboard to receive hands-on training in **hydrographic data collection and processing.**

Deployment of INS Suttlej to Mauritius stands as reaffirmation of shared commitment of both nations towards advanced scientific collaboration and strategic maritime ties. It reflects deep-rooted maritime cooperation, aimed at enhancing **navigational safety, sustainable management of ocean resources,** and **regional collaboration in the Indian Ocean Region.**
