



Department of Biotechnology (DBT) has successfully completed Special Campaign 5.0 held from 2nd October 2025 to 31st October 2025 with enthusiastic and dedicated support of its Divisions, Scientific Units and Autonomous Institutes

The campaign's preparatory phase was held from 15- 30 September 2025, and the main phase was carried out from 02nd - 31 October, 2025. Apart from overall cleanliness (Swachhata) of workplaces, space management, and optimum disposal of pending matters, the focus area of Special Campaign 5.0 was on disposal of e-waste generated in Government Offices in compliance of E-waste Management Rules 2022.

The Department has registered significant **achievements in Cleanliness, Grievance Redressal, Record Management, and scrap disposal, as under: -**
