

INDIAN NAVY SET TO COMMISSION MAHE

The Indian Navy will commission *Mahe*, the first of the Mahe-class Anti-Submarine Warfare Shallow Water Craft (ASW-SWC), at the Naval Dockyard, Mumbai, on **24 Nov 2025**.

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The ceremony, hosted by **Vice Admiral Krishna Swaminathan, Flag Officer Commanding-in-Chief, Western Naval Command**, will be presided over by **General Upendra Dwivedi, Chief of the Army Staff**.

The commissioning of *Mahe* will mark the arrival of a new generation of indigenous shallow-water combatants - sleek, swift, and resolutely Indian. **With over 80 percent indigenous content**, the Mahe-class showcases India's growing mastery in warship design, construction and integration.

She will serve as a '**Silent Hunter**' on the Western Seaboard - powered by self-reliance and dedicated to safeguarding India's maritime frontiers.





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
