In the course of time, the entire event will be opened up to the public to pay their obeisance at the feet of the life-size statue of Babasaheb Dr. B.R. Ambedkar at the Parliament House Lawn. The Mahaparinirvan Diwas of Dr. Ambedkar is annually commemorated by Dr. Ambedkar Foundation (DAF) on behalf of the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India. This is done to commemorate the death anniversary of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, a visionary social reformer, jurist, and politician.
