

ICMR-NIRRH organizes International Conference on ‘ReproNext: Emerging Horizons in Reproductive Health Research’

The International Conference on ‘ReproNext: Emerging Horizons in Reproductive Health Research’, held from 11–14 December 2025 in Mumbai, concluded with remarkable success and drew leading scientists, clinicians, and academicians from across the globe.

Organized by ICMR - National Institute for Research in Reproductive and Child Health (NIRRH) in collaboration with the Society for Reproductive Biology and Comparative Endocrinology (SRBCE), the conference also featured the 42nd Annual Meeting of SRBCE and the CME program “Conception to Cradle: Advances in Reproductive and Neonatal Genetic Medicine.”
