

CAG of India visits NADT, AG, RCBKI, Nagpur

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Shri K. Sanjay Murthy, the Comptroller and Auditor General of India (CAG) visited National Academy of Direct Taxes (NADT), Nagpur and inaugurated the 79th batch of Indian Revenue Service (IRS) Officers. While addressing the 182 IRS trainee officers, he urged them to ignore negativity and focus on their constitutional responsibility. He also underlined the need to balance legal compliance with broader national perspective, while handling complex taxation issues. He stressed upon continuous learning, collaboration with academic institutions and capacity building. He cited examples related to GST on research grants and funding for innovation and start-ups.





Subsequently, the CAG visited the office of the Accountant General (Accounts & Entitlement)-II, Nagpur, where he was welcomed by Ms. Suhasini Gotmare, IAAS, Accountant General (A&E) and Audit, Nagpur. He reviewed the functioning of Audit office, Accounts office and Training Institute within the Indian Audit and Accounts Department (IA&AD). He visited and reviewed the working of Pension sections. He emphasized on the digitalization of pension cases. He also held discussions with Senior officers of the Accountant General (Audit), Accountant General (A&E) and Regional Capacity Building and Knowledge Institute (RCBKI). He reviewed the training facilities and infrastructure at RCBKI. He interacted with the Executive Committee members of all the service Associations. During his visit, CAG planted a tree each in the premises of NADT and offices of IA & AD.
