



FCI Maharashtra Releases Rice and Wheat Stocks under OMSS (D) via e-Auction

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The Food Corporation of India (FCI), Regional Office Maharashtra, has commenced the sale of **Rice and Wheat under the Open Market Sale Scheme (Domestic) [OMSS (D)]** through **dedicated movement via e-auction**, aimed at augmenting market supplies and controlling rising food prices.

Sale of Rice under OMSS (D)

FCI, Regional Office Maharashtra, has been offering **Rice for sale under OMSS (D) from the 1st week of August 2025**. For the upcoming **e-auctions scheduled on 14.01.2026 and 15.01.2026**, a total quantity of **10,000 MT of Rice** is being offered from the Maharashtra Region.

In addition, under OMSS (D) through **dedicated movement**, FCI Maharashtra is offering **90,000 MT of Rice stocks**, comprising:

- **50,000 MT Rice**, and
- **40,000 MT Non-FRK CMR Rice with 10% broken**, including
 - 10,000 MT from **Punjab**, and
 - 30,000 MT from **Andhra Pradesh**,to be moved through dedicated rail movement for the auctions scheduled on **14.01.2026 and 15.01.2026**.

Traders, Bulk Buyers, and Rice Manufacturers are eligible to participate in the Rice e-auctions. Interested buyers may get empanelled with FCI's e-auction service provider, **m-Junction Services Limited**, through the portal:

The **empanelment process is completed within 72 hours**.

For Rice:

- **Minimum bid quantity:** 1 MT (for general Rice sale) / 2,500 MT (for dedicated movement Rice)
- **Maximum bidding quantity per bidder:** 7,000 MT

Successful bidders under dedicated movement will be required to intimate their **railhead destination** to the General Manager (Region), FCI.

Sale of Wheat under OMSS (D)

FCI Maharashtra has been offering **Wheat under OMSS (D) since the 1st week of November 2025**. For the upcoming **e-auction dated 14.01.2026**, a total quantity of **2,000 MT of Wheat** is being offered from various locations across **Maharashtra, including Goa**.

Eligible participants include **Flour Mills, Manufacturers of Wheat Products, Processors, and End Users**. The bidding norms for Wheat are as follows:

- **Minimum quantity:** 10 MT
- **Maximum quantity per bidder (all regions combined):**
- **50 MT** for Processing Units with **LT Connection**
- **300 MT** for Processing Units with **HT Connection**

Interested buyers may register with **m-Junction Services Limited**, with empanelment completed within **72 hours**.

OMSS (D) scheme will help controlling the rising prices and will bring much relief to the common man.

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
