

Group Centre, CRPF Pune Hosts the 18th Tranche of Rozgar Mela; Appointment Letters Distributed to 300 Selected Candidates

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The 18th tranche of the Rozgar Mela was organised with great enthusiasm at Group Centre, Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF), Pune, on Saturday, 24 January 2026.
