Commemorating 75 years since the commencement of India's first General Election in 1951, the Hon'ble Prime Minister described the electoral process as a "festival of democracy." He underscored India's dual identity as the "world's largest democracy" and the "Mother of Democracy."

The Prime Minister specifically addressed the volunteers of the Mera Yuva Bharat (MY Bharat), urging them to celebrate first-time voters and create awareness about the power of vote.

Highlighting the pivotal role of first-time voters, the Prime Minister stated: "To be a voter is the greatest privilege and responsibility in a democracy.
