The stall features the Division's widely acclaimed journals, which have been a staple for students and intellectuals for decades:

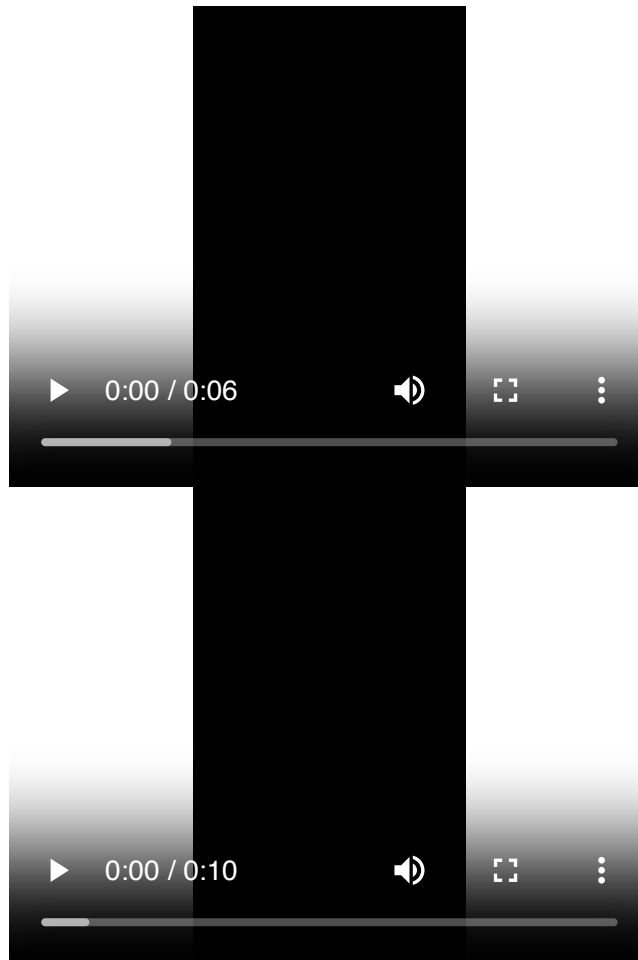
