trails in Odisha, Karnataka and Kerala will give fresh momentum to development in these regions and promote eco-tourism. Additionally, the establishment of a National Institute of Hospitality will provide youth with skills and employment opportunities and further strengthen the tourism sector.”

Union Home Minister said, “The Viksit Bharat Budget is a powerful reflection of Modi ji’s vision from education to self-employment. The development of five university townships around major industrial and logistics corridors will promote education–industry integration. At the same time, the construction and upgradation of four telescope infrastructure facilities will give fresh momentum to research.
