



National Statistics Office (NSO) to Conduct One-Day Zonal Training on National Household Income Survey at Nagpur

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The National Statistics Office (NSO), Coordination and Quality Control Division (CQCD), Zonal Office, Nagpur, under the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, Government of India, will organize a one-day Zonal Training Programme on the National Household Income Survey (NHIS) on 6 February 2026 at Nagpur.

The training for the West Zone will be held at the Indian Bureau of Mines (IBM), 3rd Floor, Indira Bhavan, Civil Lines, Nagpur. The programme will be inaugurated at 10:00 AM by Shri Srinivas Uppala, Deputy Director General, NSO (CQCD), West Zone.

The training is being conducted in preparation for the upcoming NHIS 2026, scheduled from April 2026 to March 2027. It aims to provide detailed guidance on survey concepts, definitions, and procedures to ensure uniformity and high-quality data collection. Officers from the Household Survey Division (HSD), NSO, Kolkata will impart the training.

Around 170 field officials, including Statistical Officers, Supervisors, and Enumerators from Maharashtra, Gujarat, and Chhattisgarh, will participate in the programme.

The NHIS seeks to collect comprehensive and disaggregated data on household income from various sources across rural and urban areas. The survey will help assess income distribution and financial well-being of households, supporting evidence-based policy formulation by the Government.

The National Statistics Office has been collecting socio-economic data in the country since 1950 and continues to play a vital role in strengthening India's statistical system.
