

FASTag Annual Pass Crosses 50 Lakh Users Within Six Months of Launch

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- Records strong adoption with over 50 Lakh users and 26.55 Crore total transactions within six months of launch
- Around 28% of total car users transactions recorded through Annual Pass
- Top three fee plazas for Annual Pass usage: Bijwasan in Delhi NCR with 57%, Mundaka in Delhi NCR with 53% and Jhinjholi in Sonipat with 53% of total car crossings using Annual Pass
- Top three regions: Chandigarh, Tamil Nadu and Delhi

New Delhi, 06th February 2026: Enhancing 'Ease of Commuting', the FASTag Annual Pass has achieved a significant milestone by crossing 50 lakh users with over 26.55 crore transactions recorded within six months of its launch on 15th August 2025. The milestone reflects the growing acceptance of the Annual Pass among private vehicle owners for providing a seamless and economical travel option on the National Highways and Expressways.

Highlighting the increasing preference of FASTag Annual Pass among National Highway users, around 28% of total car transactions recorded on the National Highway network are now being carried out through the FASTag Annual Pass.

The data further indicates strong adoption by the National Highway commuters, Bijwasan Fee Plaza in Delhi NCR has emerged as the leading location with around 57% of total car crossings at the fee plaza using the Annual Pass, followed by Mundaka fee plaza in Delhi NCR and Jhinjholi Fee Plaza in Sonipat, both registering around 53% of non-commercial vehicle crossings using the Annual Pass.

In addition, the region-wise analysis shows that Chandigarh leads in terms of usage, accounting for 14% of total Annual Pass transactions across the country, followed by Tamil Nadu at 12.3% and Delhi at 11.5%. These figures demonstrate widespread adoption of the annual pass across diverse geographies from Northern urban centers to Southern States.

Applicable on about 1,150 fee plazas on National Highways and National Expressways, the Annual Pass eliminates the need to frequently recharge FASTag through one-time fee payment of Rs. 3,000 for one year validity or 200 toll plaza crossings. The pass is applicable for all non-commercial vehicles with a valid FASTag. The annual pass gets activated within two hours on the existing FASTag linked to the vehicle after payment of one-time fee payment through Rajmargyatra App or NHAI website.

The growing uptake of the FASTag Annual Pass reinforces its effectiveness in promoting seamless and economical travel on National Highways across the country.
