...RESPONDENT(S):

In the light of the above grounds, it is evident that the Respondent No 1 has violated the mandatory provision of the Representation of the Peoples Act 1951 and the Guidelines laid down by the Honourable Supreme Court. There the petitioner prays for the following reliefs (a) Declare the Election of the Respondent 1 as Returned Candidate herein as Member of Lok Sabha from 6-Kakinada Parliamentary Constituency, Kakinada District, Andhra Pradesh in General Election, 2024 for which polling held on 13.5.2024 and declared result on 4.6.2024 as illegal and null and void and set aside the same. (b) Declare the acceptance of nomination papers filed by the 1st respondent/ Returned Candidate with substantial defects in Affidavit (Form 26) as illegal, improper and reject the same. (c) Award costs of the Election Petition. And pass such other order or orders as this Honourable Court deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the Case.

ORDER:

The petitioner has submitted a letter, dated 03.07.2025 to the Registrar (Judicial) seeking to withdraw the Election Petition.
