NOTIFICATION

Under Rule 10(a) of Andhra Pradesh State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1996, the following Section Officers are hereby appointed to the cadre of Deputy Collector (Category-II) of Andhra Pradesh Civil Services (Executive Branch) Rules, 1992 on purely temporary/ad-hoc basis in the Revised Scale of Pay - 2022 of Rs.61960 -151370:

The above promotion ordered on purely temporary/ad-hoc basis and is subject to the following conditions:

(i) the placement of officers as shown above (i.e., Sl. No. & Roster Point) is not based on the seniority;

(ii) the above Section Officers considered for ad-hoc / temporary appointment by transfers for the post of Deputy Collectors will be cleared by the Departmental Promotion Committee in the regular panels to be conducted in future based on their seniority;

(iii) the appointment is purely temporary under emergency provisions and does not confer any right of any kind on the individual who is liable to be reverted at any time without prior notice and without assigning any reasons thereof and the excess amount drawn, if any, in this category will be recovered;

(iv) the officer shall not be regarded as a Probationer or be entitled by reason only of such appointment to any preferential claim for future appointment to such service, class or category. Their services will be regularized against the substantive vacancy meant for them only, till such time the officer has to work on temporary / ad-hoc basis in the cadre of Deputy Collector;

(v) the ad-hoc promotions accorded are subject to outcome of pending O.As/W.Ps/ SLPs, respectively and any other cases pending before any court of law;

(vi) the appointment is also subject to joining of the Officer in the promoted post within the stipulated time of 15 (fifteen) days from the date of receipt of the order (i.e. Promotion & Posting) as specified in rule 11(b) of Andhra Pradesh State & Subordinate Service Rules, 1996, failing which they would forfeit the right of promotion by transfer to the cadre of Deputy Collector;

(vii) the posting orders to the above officers will be issued separately by the General Administration (SC.B) Department based on the vacancies available, till such time they shall continue in their present post/ place of working.

The Backward Classes Welfare (OP) Department and Youth Advancement, Tourism and Culture (OP) Departments are therefore requested to relieve the Section Officers concerned, on their posting as Deputy Collector only, so as to enable them for joining in their new assignment.

The Chief Commissioner of Land Administration, Andhra Pradesh, Mangalagiri shall take necessary further action in the matter accordingly and also requested to furnish the native District and contact phone number of the above newly promoted officers for record purpose.
