REFUND OF APPLICATION FEE OF BARS FOR LESS THAN FOUR APPLICATIONS WERE RECEIVED AND NO DRAWL OF LOTS WAS CONDUCTED - AMENDMENTS TO AP EXCISE (GRANT OF LICENSE OF SELLING BY BAR AND CONDITIONS OF LICENSE) RULES 2025.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 72 read with Sections 17, 28 and 29 of the Andhra Pradesh Excise Act, 1968 (Andhra Pradesh Act No. 17 of 1968) and by Section 12 read with Sections 6 and 7 of the AP (Regulation of Trade in IMFL, FL) Act, 1993 (Act 15 of 1993), the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following amendments to the AP Excise (Grant of license of selling by Bar and conditions of license) Rules 2025 issued in G.O. Ms. No. 276, Revenue (Excise -II) Department, Dt. 13.08.2025.

AMENDMENTS

In the said rules, the Rule 13(8) (c) shall be read as;

Rule 13(8)(c) :-

No selection for grant of a bar licence shall be conducted, unless a minimum of four applications are received for that particular bar. In such case, the last date and time fixed for receipt of applications for that particular bar shall be extended till such date, as the Commissioner of Prohibition and Excise may direct.

Provided that in case four or more applications are not received even after extension of last date and time and no selection process is conducted, the non-refundable application fee(s) shall be returned/refunded to the applicant(s).

The Director, Excise & Prohibition, AP, shall take further necessary action accordingly.
