SURESH, OFFICE SUBORDINATE, HIGH COURT OF ANDHRA PRADESH - UNAUTHORISED ABSENCE TO DUTIES SINCE 03.04.2025 - OFFICIAL MEMORANDUM AND SHOW CAUSE NOTICE ISSUED - RETURNED UN-SERVED - NOTICE PUBLISHED IN THE ANDHRA PRADESH GAZETTE - NO REPLY - INDIVIDUAL DISCHARGED FROM SERVICE AS PER RULE 11(1) OF THE SERVICE RULES OF HIGH COURT OF ANDHRA PRADESH, 2025.

Sri P. Suresh, was appointed as 'Office Subordinate' in the High Court Service with effect from 24.02.2023 and is under probation. When Sri P.Suresh, Office Subordinate, was un-authorisedly absent from duties 03.04.2025, the Registry had issued an Official Memorandum in the reference 1st cited but it remained un-served. Later, the Registry has issued a Show Cause Notice in the reference 2nd cited, stating as to why he should not be discharged from service under Rule 11 of the Service Rules of High Court of Andhra Pradesh, 2019 but it was also returned un-served.

As per Rule 42 of A.P. Civil Services (C.C. & A.) Rules, 1991, the Notice dated 02.01.2026 was published in Andhra Pradesh Gazette Part-II Extraordinary on 03.02.2026 directing to show cause as to why P.Suresh should not be discharged from service for his un-authorised absence from duty from 03.04.2025 onwards, but it evoked no response.

Since, Sri P. Suresh, Office Subordinate neither submitted any written explanation for absence nor reported to duty in the High Court, and as he is under probation, Sri P Suresh is discharged from High Court Service, as per Rule 11(1) of the Service Rules of the High Court of Andhra Pradesh, 2025, with effect from 03.04.2025 i.e., the date from which the individual remained absent to duty un-authorisedly. The individual would be entitled of such benefits which are permissible under Law consequently to his discharge.
