In exercise of the powers conferred on the High Court under section 21 of the Family Courts Act, 1984 and enabling provisions in that behalf the High Court hereby incorporate the following Rule as Rule 7A in the Family Court (Andhra Pradesh) Rules, 2005:

- 7 A: Not withstanding anything contained in Rule No.7 soon after the appearance of the parties, the matter shall be referred to the Family Court counseling Centre for settlement of the dispute. If the Counsellor settles the dispute, he/she shall file a report which includes terms of settlement. The Court shall pass an order in terms of the settlement report. If the parties fail to reach a settlement, the Court shall proceed with the trial of the case. Till the filing of his/her report before the Court by the Counsellor, the Pleadings of the parties need not be served on opposite party.

Provided that in case of urgency, the Court may order/permit service of pleadings of parties on the opposite party even before the filing of the report by the Counsellor.
