NOTIFICATION

In pursuance of the policy decision of the Government under PA-19
(Priority Area -19) and in order to facilitate ease of practice for qualified
medical practitioners, the Government of Andhra Pradesh hereby notifies
that:

- I. Any person possessing a recognized medical qualification and holding
a valid registration with any State Medical Council or Union Territory
Medical Council in India shall be permitted to practice in the State of
Andhra Pradesh.
- II. Such practitioner shall not be required to obtain:
 - (i) Separate registration from the Andhra Pradesh Medical Council
solely for the purpose of practice in Andhra Pradesh; or

- (ii) No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the State Medical Council or Union Territory Medical Council where he/she is registered.
- III. The Andhra Pradesh Medical Council may obtain such particulars, declarations and information through its online portal as may be required for verification and maintenance of records.
- IV. Nothing contained in this notification shall exempt any medical practitioner from compliance with the provisions of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019, applicable regulations, professional ethics, disciplinary proceedings or any other law for the time being in force.

This notification shall come into force with immediate effect.
