APPOINTMENT OF SPECIAL JUDICIAL MAGISTRATES OF II CLASS, PRAKASAM DISTRICT - CONFERMENT OF POWERS UNDER SUB-SECTIONS (1) AND (2) OF SECTION 11 OF THE BHARATIYA NAGARIKA SURAKSHA SANHITA, 2023 - NOTIFIED.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-sections (1) and (2) of Section 11 of the Bharatiya Nagarika Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 governing appointment of Special Judicial Magistrates of II Class, the High Court of Andhra Pradesh, hereby confers on the persons mentioned in column (2) of the tables given below, all the powers of Special Judicial Magistrates of II Class, to exercise at the places shown in column (3) in respect of particular cases or particular classes of cases, as may be specified by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Prakasam District, to enable them to function as Special Judicial Magistrates of II Class, in their respective stations in Prakasam District. The term of appointment of the persons mentioned in Col.No 3 of the **Table-I** is for a period of **ONE YEAR**, from the date they assume charge of their respective posts, **or till they attain the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier** and the term of the persons mentioned in Col.No.2 of the **Table-II** is for the period upto **31st March**,

2026, subject to extension of the same by the Government for further period, is any case not exceeding one year from the date of assuming of charge or till they attains the age of 65 Years whichever is earlier, subject to the following conditions:-

- (a) If any of the individual refuses or does not join within Fifteen (15) days from the date of issue of the notification, he/she shall forfeit his/her claim to the post of Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class, forever.
- (b) He/She will be removed from service without being called upon to show cause, if he/she failed to attend three (3) Consecutive sittings of the Court, without written permission of the Chief Judicial Magistrate.
- (c) The services of the officers appointed shall be liable to be terminated at any time without any notice.
