efficient management of port areas, it is necessary to review and rationalize the limits. The proposed revision will avoid unnecessary inclusion of excessive land areas while ensuring adequate extent for future port development, navigational requirements, and associated maritime activities.

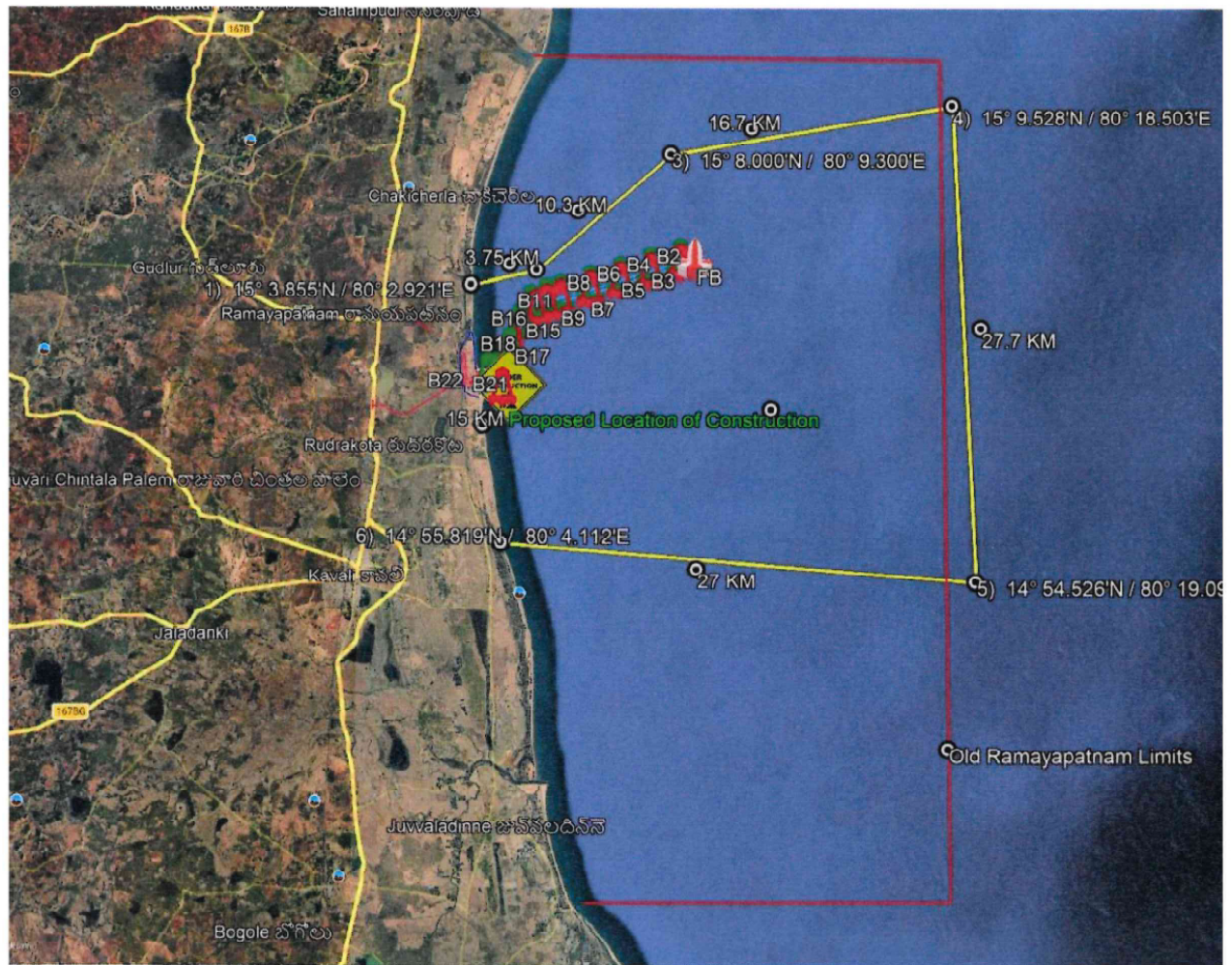
