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ORDER :-

Sri J. Mallikarjuna Rao, PC-229 of HQ Coy., of this Unit has handed up with a charge under Rule 20 of APCS (CC & A) Rules 1991 vide this office charge memo vide reference 1st cited above for the following delinquency:-

“Exhibited gross dereliction of duty and reprehensible conduct by absenting himself from duty unauthorisedly without obtaining leave or permission and also without intimating his whereabouts to the concerned officers w.e.f. 21-05-2024 AN and thus committed the offence of desertion”.

The above charge memo was communicated to the PC-229 through OC, HQ Coy. OC, HQ Coy has sent to his residential address by Spl. Messenger, but the charged officer was not found in the house. The OC HQ Coy., XI Bn., APSP, Bhakarapet, Kadapa stated that, Sri Y.J. Subba Reddy, PC 1019 ‘HQ’ Coy., was deputed to serve a copy of the memorandum of charge of Sri J. Mallikarjuna Rao, PC 229 to Sri J. Mallikarjuna Rao, PC-229 residential address, Door No. 08/12, Tamba Bhavi Veedhi, Porumamilla Town, Kadapa. Due to the non availability of the said PC 229, his wife was contacted and she has said that the above PC 229 has not been available since January 2024. Further, Sri Y.J. Subba Reddy, PC 1019 went to the local police station in Porumamilla and explained to the SHO about the difficulty in serving the memorandum copy of PC 229. Then the SHO sent him along with the station PC 2404 to the Address of Door No. 08/12, Tamba Bhavi Street, Porumamilla Town, Kadapa and inquired and found that Door No. 08/12 was dilapidated. Later, beside door to the house of PC 229 is his brother’s house which is Door No. 08/13. PC 1019 gave him the memorandum copy of PC 229 and took a photo of him. But after taking the photo, his brother refused to take the memorandum copy, so they explained the same to the said SHO. After that, SHO, knowing from station constable, confirmed that PC 229 was not available and gave a confirmation letter along with a copy of PC 229 memorandum, which was submitted back to the HQ Coy office by Sri Y. J. Subba Reddy, PC 1019 of XI Bn., APSP, Bhakarapet, Kadapa.

Further, Sri P.N.D. Prasad, Asst. Commandant, 11th Bn., AP. Special Police, Bhakarapet, YSR District who was appointed as Enquiry Officer vide reference 2nd cited, had conducted oral enquiry against PC-229 and submitted his minutes of enquiry, holding the charges against the Charged Officer as ‘Proved’ vide reference 3rd cited above. The charged officer was not attended for the OE and conducted the enquiry on ex-parte.

A copy of minutes of enquiry was supplied to the Charged Officer and called for his further representation vide reference 4th cited above through OC HQ Coy.

OC, HQ Coy had sent to his home address by Spl. Messenger, but the charged officer was not found in the house. The enquiry report was served on his brother Sri J.Firoji Rao and obtained acknowledgement on 20-08-2025. His brother stated that, his brother PC-229 is not coming to home and does not know his whereabouts.

Further, a copy of final show cause notice vide reference 5th cited above has been communicated to the charged officer PC-229 through OC, HQ Coy. OC, HQ Coy sent to his home address by Spl. Messenger, but the charged officer was not found in the house. The final show cause notice was served on his brother wife J.Joshi Bai and obtained acknowledgement on 28-09-2025. He is not coming to home and does not know his whereabouts.

Therefore, the final show cause notice was sent to the Commissioner, Govt., Central Press, Vijayawada vide reference 6th cited above publish in AP Gazette. The final show cause notice against PC-229 was published in AP Gazette on 11-12-2025 vide reference 7th cited above.

I have gone through the written statement of defence of charged officer and other relevant records carefully. The Charged Officer PC-229 was deliberately absented for duty for more than one year w.e.f.21-05-2024 without leave or permission unauthorizedly to till date which speaks his carelessness towards his legitimate duties. The conduct of the charged officer in absenting for duties is highly reprehensible and sheer negligence on part of him. He failed to submit his explanation even though he was given adequate opportunity to prove his innocence. Hence, it is construed that he has no explanation to offer and the OEPR is disposed off ex-parte on its merits.

In view of above, I totally agree with the findings of Enquiry Officer and held the charges leveled against the PC-229 as proved. Hence, I award the charged officer PC-229 with the punishment of “Removal from service with immediate effect and his desertion period from 21-05-2024 AN to 31-12-2025 is treated as Not on duty” in terms of G.O.Ms.No.260, General Administration (SER.C) Departmental, dated:04-09-2003.

Certified that the procedure laid down under Rule 20 of APCS (CC&A) Rules, 1991 have strictly been followed.
