- (i) No direct recruitment shall be made specifically to any post borne on the establishment of the offices notified above.
- (ii) The posts shall be filled by transfer, deputation or tenure posting of eligible officers and employees drawn from the respective local cadres or other eligible local cadres of the Commercial Taxes Department.
- (iii) The officers and employees so posted shall retain their lien, seniority, promotional prospects and other service rights in their respective parent cadres.
- (iv) Service in any of the above Special Offices shall not confer any right to permanent absorption, regularisation, seniority or local status in such office.
- (v) The tenure, deployment and repatriation of officers and employees shall be regulated by the Chief Commissioner of State Tax in accordance with the applicable service rules and Government instructions.
- (vi) The notification shall not, by itself, create any new post or entail any additional financial commitment.
- (vii) The notification shall not alter the statutory jurisdiction, powers or functions of any officer under the Andhra Pradesh Goods and Services Tax Act, 2017, which shall continue to be governed by the said Act and the orders issued thereunder.
