FIXATION OF INTERIM FEE STRUCTURE FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-27 TENTATIVELY FOR SUPER SPECIALITY COURSES IN PRIVATE UN-AIDED PROFESSIONAL MEDICAL AND DENTAL COLLEGES IN THE STATE OF ANDHRA PRADESH, BY ENHANCING AT THE RATE OF 15% ON THE EXISTING FEE NOTIFIED FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-26.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 7 of Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1983 (Act No.5 of 1983), the Government hereby notify the interim fee structure for the Academic Year 2026-27 tentatively for Super Speciality Courses in Private Un-Aided Professional Medical and Dental Colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh, by enhancing at the rate of 15% on the existing fee notified for the Academic Year 2025-26 in G.O.Rt.No.778, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, dt.09.11.2025, subject to final fixation /recommendations of the fee by the APHEFRMC, and directions/outcome of the WPs., if any, pending at Hon'ble High Court of A.P and Hon'ble Supreme Court of India:

All the Private Un-Aided Professional Medical and Dental colleges concerned in the State of Andhra Pradesh shall abide by the following conditions and guidelines:

- The institutions/colleges shall collect only the "fee" as defined under sub-section (15) of Section 2 of the Andhra Pradesh Higher Education Fee Regulatory and Monitoring Act, 2019 (Act No.20 of 2019), as amended from time to time.
- No institution / college shall collect, directly or indirectly and under any head, description or guise whatsoever any amount in excess of the interim fee notified herein.
- The interim fee hereby proposed is effective for the Academic Year 2026-27 only and shall not extend to any subsequent academic year. Upon the Committee notifying its final determination of the fee, the fee so determined shall automatically supersede this interim fee.
- On such supersession, the difference between the interim fee and the fee finally determined by the Committee shall be given effect to, where the fee finally determined is lower, the institution/ college shall refund or adjust the excess collected to the student concerned; and where it is higher, the differential shall be recoverable in accordance with the Committee's determination and the extant fee-reimbursement arrangements. Every institution/ college shall, before commencing admissions, furnish an undertaking to the affiliating University to abide by the final determination of the Committee and to give effect to such refund or adjustment.
- Every institution/ college shall, at the time of admission, communicate to the student in writing that the fee fixed for the Academic Year 2026- 27 is interim and tentative and is liable to revision for that very year upon the final determination of the Committee, and that the resulting differential shall be adjusted, refunded or recovered accordingly.

The Registrar, Dr.N.T.R University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada and the Principals of all Private Un-Aided Professional Medical and Dental Colleges concerned shall take necessary action accordingly.
