AMENDMENT TO THE A.P. PRIVATE MEDICAL / DENTAL UN-AIDED NON- MINORITY
PROFESSIONAL INSTITUTIONS (ADMISSIONS INTO POST GRADUATE MEDICAL /
DENTAL COURSES RULES, 2017.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 3 and 15 of the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1983 (A.P. Act No: 5 of 1983), the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby notify the following amendments to the Andhra Pradesh Un-aided Non-Minority Professional Institutions (Regulation of Admissions into Post Graduate Medical and Dental Professional Courses) Rules, 2017 issued in G.O.Ms. No.70, HM&FW (C1) Department, Dated:03.09.2017 and as amended subsequently from time to time:

In Rule-2 Definitions	
(iii) "Committee for admissions" means the Committee nominated by the Competent Authority to select and make allotment of candidates to Competent Authority Seats in Professional Institutions offering P.G. Medical and Dental Courses in the State for Admissions in accordance with the rules laid down.	(iii)(a) "Committee of Admissions" means the Committee constituted by the Competent Authority which shall fix modalities as per prevailing NMC/NDC/MCC/Govt/UHS Regulations as amended from time to time for Management Quota admissions only before issue of admission notification for online applications. (iii)(b) "Selection Committee" means the committee constituted by the Competent Authority to select and make allotment of candidates to Professional institutions offering P.G. Seat Sharing and Admissions:	
i) The Association of Private Medical & Dental Colleges Management of AP members, imparting studies in Post Graduate education in Medical and Dental Sciences Courses in their respective Institutions, would make available 50% of intake of their seats course wise out of the total intake available, in each of their member - Medical and Dental Colleges, to the Government's PG Admission Cell for counseling and allocation of seats; based on merit; as per ranking to be determined/assigned by the competent authority based on National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET-PG /NEET-MDS), as the case may be, and as per Rules framed for the purpose in accordance with the terms of this agreement.	Competent Authority Quota(CQ): i) 50% of the sanctioned intake of seats course wise out of total intake available, in each member of the Association of Private Medical & Dental Colleges Management of AP imparting studies in Post Graduate education in Medical and Dental Sciences Courses shall be made available to the Competent Authority for counselling and allocation of seats by Selection Committee based on merit; as per ranking to be determined/assigned by the competent authority based on National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET-PG /NEET-MDS), as the case may be, and as per Rules framed for the purpose in accordance with the NMC/NDC, New Delhi/Dr. NTR UHS, Vijayawada from time to time.
vi) The unfilled seats after final phase of counseling for competent authority seats shall be surrendered to Management of respective colleges. If a candidate allotted a seat after final counseling of the convener quota fails to join the course in a private college, that seat can be filled by the Management of respective institutions with eligible candidates.	vi) deleted
vii) The 50% of the sanctioned intake of the seats (Management quota) to member institutions of APMDCMA shall be filled by the APMDCMA Counselling /Admission committee under the categories listed hereunder with the eligible candidates on the basis of inter se merit among the applicants qualified in NEET-PG/NEET-MDS.	vii) The 50% of the sanctioned intake of the seats (Management quota) shall be filled by the Selection Committee constituted by the competent authority under these rules under the categories listed based on inter-se-merit; as per ranking to be determined/assigned by the competent authority based on National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET-PG/NEET-MDS), as the case may be, and as per Rules framed for the purpose in accordance with the NMC/NDC, New Delhi/Dr. NTR UHS, Vijayawada from time to time.
In Rule 2, under seat sharing admissions vii(b) the following clause shall be inserted.	
Vii) b) I) <u>NRI Lapsed seats:</u>	

NRI quota seats which remain vacant after exhausting choices from all NRI applicants will be converted to NRI lapsed seats in the Phase-III (Mop Up) or subsequent phase(s) of counselling and shall be filled based on merit from the merit list under Management Quota, prepared as per NEET Ranks.

vii(e) As per the discretion of the Competent Authority, possible number of Mop Up rounds of counselling are to be conducted by Dr YSR University of Health Sciences for PG (Medical)/PG (Dental) Management Quota Subcategory-1/ Subcategory-2/ Subcategory-3 seats before the last date of admission as per NMC, New Delhi schedule.	vii (e) As per the discretion of the Competent Authority, possible number of Stray Vacancy rounds of counselling are to be conducted by Dr NTR University of Health Sciences for PG (Medical)/PG (Dental) Management Quota Subcategory seats before the last date of admission as per NMC/NDC schedule.
viii) On non-availability of candidates in any of the categories in vii (a), (b) or (c), they can be filled from any other eligible candidates as prescribed by the Medical Council of India/ Dental Council of India and the fee shall be on par with these category of students admitted under vii (c).	viii) In the event of non-availability of eligible candidates in Phase-III (Mop-Up) or any subsequent phase(s) of counselling, the vacant seats shall be filled as follows: 1. The vacant Sub-Category-2 (NRI) seats shall first be treated as NRI Lapsed Seats and shall be filled, in the order of merit, from among the other eligible candidates under the Management Quota. The candidates so admitted shall pay the tuition fee applicable to Sub-Category-2 (NRI) seats. 2. Procedure for Grant of Admissions into PG [Medical, Dental] Courses under the Management Quota Seats:

1. The State Government shall constitute a committee consisting of three members i.e., one from the Government, one from	1. The Committee for Admission constituted by the Competent Authority as defined in the University Act consisting of three members
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University of Health Sciences and the other from APPMDCMA for the purpose of Counselling/Admission to member institutions of AP Private Medical & Dental Colleges Managements Association. The member representative of APMDCMA shall be the convener of the counselling/admission committee. The entire procedure shall be done under overall supervision of Dr. NTR UHS, Vijayawada.	including a one representative from APPMDCMA for the purpose of fixing the modalities as per prevailing NMC/NDC/MCC//Govt./UHS Regulations as amended from time to time for Management Quota only before issue of admission notification for online applications.

The Convener, Admission/ Counseling Committee shall issue notification in two National Newspapers, calling for application from NEET-PG/NEET-MDS qualified candidates for admission to management quota (Sub-Category 1) and Management quota (Subcategory 2 & 3) in PG Medical / Dental courses separately. The admission process and number of seats under management quota shall be displayed in the Association Website.	2. The Competent Authority shall issue notification in one National Edition English Daily Newspaper and also in one AP State Edition Telugu Daily Newspaper, calling for application from NEET-PG/NEET-MDS qualified candidates for admission to management quota in PG Medical / Dental courses. The admission process and number of seats under management quota shall be displayed in the University Website.

He shall invite Online or Offline Applications in the form prescribed by it, from the NEET-PG or NEET-MDS eligible candidates for participating in Centralized Admission Process (CAP) for seeking admission to the Courses to management quota (Sub-Category 1,) and (Sub-Category 2 & 3) separately	3. The Competent Authority shall issue notification inviting Online Applications only from the NEET-PG or NEET-MDS eligible candidates for participating in Web Counselling for admission to the Courses to management quota. The candidates shall pay Non-Refundable Application fee, Counselling fee and University fee through online.
4. He shall prepare a merit list from the eligible candidates who have applied to the Management Quota seats, online or offline, in the prescribed form for admission to Post Graduate Medical Courses and Post Graduate Dental Courses on the basis of the marks at percentile in the NEET-PG examination or NEET-MDS examination.	4. 7. Counseling will be held separately for Management Quota – Subcategory 1 and Management Quota – Subcategory 2 & 3.	7. Counselling will be held simultaneously for all subcategories of Management Quota as per the Counselling procedure notified by the Competent Authority.
8. The Selected candidate will be issued Provisional Selection Intimation with a direction to report to the concerned Principal within the date specified.	8. The Selected candidate shall download the Allotment Order by paying non-refundable University Fee as prescribed and to report to the concerned Principal within the date specified.
9. If a candidate opts a seat and fails to pay the fee at respective institution, the seat will be treated as vacant and will be filled in the 2 nd Counselling.	9. If a candidate allotted a seat and fails to pay the fee at respective institution and/or fails to report to the Principal within the stipulated time, the Selection and Admission of the candidate will be cancelled automatically. Such cancelled seat will be treated as vacant and will be filled in the subsequent counselling(s).
10. If a selected candidate fails to report to the Principal within the stipulated time, the Selection and Admission of the candidate will be cancelled automatically and the seat will be filled in the 2 nd Counselling.	10. Same as 9 above
11. The Certificates of the Candidates will be sent to the respective colleges after closure of admissions to management quota seats.	11. The selected candidate has to report to the allotted college with all Original Certificates and to report to the concerned Principal within the date specified.
12. The Convener, Admission / Counselling Committee shall notify the Venue, Date and Time of 2 nd Counselling to fill-up the vacant seats if any, after 1 st counselling.	12. deleted

The Admissions into Management Quota seats will be closed at the end of 2 nd Counselling and the candidates who were admitted will be considered as the Bonafide Candidates of the respective colleges. The Fee paid by the candidates and the Original Certificates will be sent to the respective colleges.	13. The Admissions into Management Quota seats will be closed as per the Counselling Schedule notified by MCC from time to time.
14. The College Fee shall be paid in the form of crossed demand draft in favour of "Secretary, APMDCMA" payable at Vijayawada / Rajahmundry.	14. Candidates selected shall report at the allotted college with all the Original Certificates and necessary documents and shall pay the prescribed fees either online or through a Demand Draft, as permitted by the allotted college within the notified date and time. If a candidate fails to pay the fee on the day of

	admission, the selection will be cancelled forthwith and will be filled with subsequent phases of counselling as per the prescribed procedure.
16. The Candidates are bound by the Regulations to be made by the Association with regard to Admission, Cancellation and Withdrawal from the Course.	16. The Candidates are bound by the Regulations prescribed by the NMC/NDC/MCC/Government/Competent Authority from time to time.
17. The APMDCMA shall constitute a Grievance Redressal Committee composed of a Dean/Principal of a Medical/Dental College, one eminent person in public service and one member nominated by the university. Any grievance as to the determination of their merit and entitlement for admissions, cancellation of seats, refund of fees, return of documents, etc., the students or the colleges concerned must approach the Grievance Redressal Committee headed by a Principal/Dean/Director of a Medical/Dental college and the decision of Grievance Redressal Committee shall be binding on both Parties.	17. The Selection Committee for admissions shall examine and resolve the grievances, if any, received from the students on the counselling till the closure of admissions.

The Registrar, Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, is instructed to implement the above guidelines subject to the following safe guards:

- a) all vacancies and category-wise seat matrices should be published in real time
- b) even a single seat should remain with the University and never revert to colleges for direct admission
