AMENDMENT TO THE ANDHRA PRADESH UN-AIDED NON-MINORITY PROFESSIONAL INSTITUTIONS REGULATIONS OF ADMISSIONS INTO UNDER GRADUATE MEDICAL AND DENTAL PROFESSIONAL COURSES) RULES, 2007.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 3 and 15 of the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1983 (A.P. Act No. 5 of 1983) the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the Andhra Pradesh Un-aided Non-Minority Professional Institutions Regulations of Admissions into Under Graduate Medical and Dental Professional Courses) Rules, 2007 issued in G.O.Ms.No.136, Health Medical & Family Welfare (E1) Department, dated:30.04.2007 and as amended subsequently from time to time:

Rule 2 (1) Definitions	
iii. "Committee for admissions" means the committee constituted by the Competent Authority to select and make allotment of candidates to Professional institutions offering Medical and Dental courses in the State for admissions in accordance with the provisions laid down".	(iii) "Committee for admissions" means the committee constituted by the Competent Authority to fix modalities for admissions into Professional institutions offering Medical and Dental courses in the State in accordance with the provisions laid down".

In the said rule 2(1) under definitions, after clause (xiv), the following clause shall be inserted

(xv) "Selection Committee" means the committee constituted by the Competent Authority to select and make allotment of candidates to Professional institutions offering Medical and Dental courses in the State for admissions in accordance with the provisions laid down.

The candidates selected for admission into unaided private non-minority Professional colleges shall pay the prescribed fee in the form of demand draft drawn on any national bank in favour of "The Secretary, APMDCMA payable at Rajahmundry / Vijayawada. If a candidate fails to pay the fee on the day of selection, the selection will be cancelled forthwith and will be filled with subsequent selection by counseling as per the prescribed procedure.	viii d. Candidates selected shall report at the allotted college within the notified date and time and shall pay the prescribed fees at the time of admission. If a candidate fails to pay the fee on the day of admission, the selection will be cancelled forthwith and will be filled with subsequent selection by counseling as per the prescribed procedure.
viii. e. The fee so collected in the form as mentioned above shall be kept with the APMDCMA till admission process is completed. Soon after the completion of the admission process, the fee so collected shall be transferred to the college concerned.	viii. e deleted

If a candidate after 1st counselling fails to report to the principals of respective colleges on or before the stipulated time, he / she shall be deemed to have forfeited the seat and all such category B and C (NEETUG ranking based management seats) unfilled seats shall be filled by conducting second counselling.	viii. g. deleted

Rule 6 (B) under item viii	
4. The Sub rule “f” is substituted as “Once a candidate secures admission to a particular college / course based on the his / her option in the 1st counseling, such candidate shall be allowed for sliding for admission into other college / course in the 2nd counseling. No more claims to admission into other colleges / course be entertained after 2nd counseling during that academic year.	4. Sliding to other college / course shall be allowed upto Phase-III counselling on par with the counselling scheme of All India Quota notified by Medical Counselling Committee from time to time. However, once a candidate allotted a seat in a college under Management Quota (Category-B or Category-C(NRI)) in any phase upto Phase-III and if not reported in the allotted seat, the candidate shall not be allowed to opt that particular seat again in any phase.
5. The Sub-rule “h” is substituted as “ The admissions through counseling into management quota seats will be closed after mop-up counseling and the candidates who were admitted will be considered as the bonafide candidates of the respective colleges.	5. The Sub-rule “h” deleted
6. Sub rule “i” is substituted as “ All unfilled seats after Mop-up counseling of Category-A in private Un-aided Non-Minority Medical and Dental Colleges will be surrendered to the Convenor of the Committee for admissions constituted by the competent authority i.e. Vice – Chancellor. Such unfilled seats will be treated as Category-B seats and added to the available Category-B vacancies and filled in subsequent counseling for Management quota seats. If any seats fall vacant after Mop-up counseling (stray vacancies) for Category B & Category C such seats will be surrendered to the Principals of the individual colleges. Such seats shall be filled by the Principals of the individual colleges on merit through NEET-UG ranking from the merit list as per the rules of Government of India / Apex bodies issued in this regard.	6. (q) The committee for admissions shall examine and resolve the grievances, if any, received from the students on the counselling till the closure of admissions.	(q) The Selection committee for admissions shall examine and resolve the grievances, if any, received from the students on the counselling till the closure of admissions.

In the said rule, under Rule 6(C)(IV), the following clause shall be inserted.

6(C)(IV)(i) NRI Lapsed seats:

NRI quota seats which remain vacant after exhausting choices from all NRI applicants will be converted to NRI lapsed seats in the Phase-III (Mop Up) or subsequent phase(s) of counselling and shall be filled based on merit from the merit list under Management Quota, prepared as per NEET Ranks subject to conditions that the candidate has to submit Bank Guarantee for NRI lapsed category fee to avoid blocking of seats.

The Registrar, Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, is instructed to implement the above guidelines subject to the following safe guards:

- a) all vacancies and category-wise seat matrices should be published in real time
- b) even a single seat should remain with the University and never revert to colleges for direct admission.
