AD-HOC RULES FOR THE ANDHRA PRADESH LEGISLATURE ENGINEERING SERVICE.

[G.O.Ms.No.30, Legislature (O.P.I), 2nd September, 2026.]

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (3) of Article 187 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh, after consultation with the Chairman of the Andhra Pradesh Legislative Council and the Speaker of the Andhra Pradesh Legislative Assembly, hereby makes the following Ad-hoc rules for the Andhra Pradesh Legislature Engineering Service:

AD-HOC RULES

- 1. Short Title:-** (i) These Rules may be called the Andhra Pradesh Legislature Engineering Service Rules.
(ii) These rules shall come into force with effect from 01.09.2026
- 2. Constitution:-** The Andhra Pradesh Legislature Engineering Service shall consist of the following Categories of posts, namely:-
 - Category 1- Technical Officer
 - Category 2- Assistant Radio Executive Engineer
 - Category 3- Additional Radio Assistant Engineer

- 3. Applicability of General and Special Rules:** The Andhra Pradesh State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1996, the Andhra Pradesh Civil Services (Conduct) Rules, 1964 and the Andhra Pradesh Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1991 amendments from time to time shall apply to the Members of this service.
- 4. Appointing Authority:** The appointing authority shall be the Secretary-General to State Legislature or the Secretary in the absence of Secretary-General.
- 5. Method of Appointment:-** Appointment to service for different categories of posts specified in columns (1) and (2) respectively of Annexure-1 appended to these rules shall be made by the method specified against the corresponding entry in column (3) thereof.
- 6. Qualifications:-** No person shall be eligible for appointment to any of the posts referred to in column (2) of Annexure-II appended to these rules by any of the methods specified in the corresponding entries in column (3) thereof, unless he/she possesses the qualifications specified in the corresponding entries in column (4) thereof.
- 7. Age:-** No person shall be eligible for Direct Recruitment if he/she is less than 18 years of age and unless otherwise specified in the special or ad-hoc Rules and if he/she is more than "34 years of age" on the 1st July of the year in which the notification for selection to the relevant post, category or class or a service is issued.
- 8. Reservation of Appointment:-** The rule of Special Representation (General Rule 22, 22A and 22B of the Andhra Pradesh State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1996 shall apply to appointments by direct recruitment/ promotion/ transfer to various categories in this service. And in case of Reservation to PBD candidates, the G.O.Ms.No.7, Legislature (O.P.I) Secretariat, Dated:12.02.2026 prevails.
- 9. Promotion:-** No member of the service shall be eligible for promotion to a higher category, unless he/she has completed three years of service, of which at least two years shall be in the category from which such promotion is to be made exclusive of any period of service rendered in any other Department other than the departments of Secretariat.
- 10. Probation:-** Every person, appointed to any category shall, from the date on which he/she joins duty, be on probation as follows:-
 - (i) for a direct recruit
 - for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years

- (ii) if appointed by promotion – for a total period of one year on duty within continuous period of two years.
or by transfer

11. Seniority of members appointed to the Service by transfer:-

- i. The seniority of a person who is transferred on administrative grounds from any department of the Secretariat or any other service to the Legislature Secretariat shall be fixed in the latter department with reference to the date of his/her first appointment in the department from which he/she is transferred.
- ii. The person who is transferred to the Legislature Secretariat at his/her own request shall have his/her seniority fixed in the Legislature Secretariat with reference to the date of his/her appointment in the Legislature Secretariat.

12. Power to relax rules:

Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules or in the special rules, the Governor in consultation with the Chairman of the Andhra Pradesh Legislative Council and the Speaker of the Andhra Pradesh Legislative Assembly shall have the power to relax any rules contained in these rules or special rules.
