NOTIFICATIONS BY GOVERNMENT

(EXCISE-II)

AMENDMENT TO THE A.P. EXCISE ACT, 1968 - NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION-47(1).

[G.O.Ms.No.583, Revenue (Excise-II), 11th September, 2026.]

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 47 (1) of the Andhra Pradesh Excise Act, 1968, and in continuation to the orders issued in G.O.Ms.No.12, Revenue (Excise-II) Department, Dated:08.01.2018 and G.O.Ms.No.278, Revenue (Excise) Dept., Dated: 02.12.2024, the Government of Andhra Pradesh hereby specifies the following for compounding of offences:

- 1) The following offences / violations committed by Shop licensee for the first time can be compounded for Rs.10 Lakhs and for the second time the Shop license may be cancelled after giving a reasonable opportunity of being heard with a notice period of (7) days:
 - a) MRP violation;
 - b) Any activity associated with Non-Duty Paid Liquor;
 - c) Brand Mixing, adulteration or dilution of liquor;
 - d) Non-maintenance of e-Inventory.

- 2) Deliberate disruption of CCTV feed or tampering with the system by the licensee for the first time may be compounded for Rs. 50,000, for the second time for Rs. 1,00,000 and for the third time the licence may be cancelled after giving a reasonable opportunity of being heard with a notice period of (7) days.
- 3) The orders issued in GO Ms. No.12, Revenue (Excise-II) Department, dated 08-01-2018 and G.O.Ms.No.278, Revenue (Excise) Dept., Dated: 02.12.2024, may be applied for compounding the offences mentioned in Section 47 (1) of AP Excise Act, 1968 except the offences / violations mentioned in Clause (1) of this order. However, the offences committed by the Bar licensees may be dealt with as per the proviso under Section 47 (1) of AP Excise Act, 1968.
