Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the tribal communities have come out with more than 100 recommendations covering various aspects during their recent brainstorming session, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether they have demanded strengthening of the Forest Rights Act and the expansion of Forest Rights Committees, if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether they have demanded the resolution of long-pending tribal land disputes through appropriate mechanisms including a judicial commission, if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether the Government is considering to address the issues raised by them, if so, the details thereof?
