

Regarding need for comprehensive measures to harness various potential water bodies in Jharkhand through Integrated Irrigation Scheme-Laid

DR. NISHIKANT DUBEY (GODDA): The second state irrigation commission has made an assessment of the water resource in Jharkhand and identified 16 river basins which can be harnessed through major, medium and minor irrigation scheme. The commission had identified potential for these Reservoir scheme where people of my state need kind attention such as Kalipur Resorvoir Scheme; Bhurbhuri Reservoir Scheme; Bishanpur reservoir scheme; Jamunia Reservior Scheme; Banslai reservoir Scheme; Dumaria beer in Godda; Pakaria Beer in Godda; Sugga Bathan Reservoir Scheme; Krishnasagar reservoir Scheme; I am also highlighting the old and ongoing projects for your consideration viz., Punasi: waiting for forest clearance in Delhi; Triveni: Tender of brick lining is awaited; Suga Bathan: DPR is in process, project started in 1978; Sundar Dam and Harna beer: Closed since 1980; Budhai: Foundation stone laid in 1978, clearance awaited in CWC; Saidapur & Tardiha beer: DPR is awaited; Darhwa & Dahua beer: Money given through 13th Finance Commission; Kajhia, Sonapur, Bhoura Bandh, Lahtan Pakaria Extension; Krishnasagar: Work started in 1985; Trikut Jalashaya : waiting for Forest clearance; Raja Bandh & Mahagama Canal: Pending since 1985; 200 Lift irrigation projects of minor irrigation; Major ponds: Centre allocating funds in RRR Policy and Series Check dams under AIBP, as much as 90%, but state unable to take advantage.
