



## **"From Remembrance to Responsibility": Smt. Raksha Khadse Calls Youth to Carry Forward Legacy of Martyrs on Shaheed Diwas**

**10,000 youth join “MY Bharat, MY Responsibility” padyatra, reinforcing commitment to Viksit Bharat 2047**

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On the occasion of Shaheed Diwas, Union Minister of State for Youth Affairs & Sports, Smt. Raksha Nikhil Khadse, led a “MY Bharat, MY Responsibility” padyatra in Faridabad, organised by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports under the MY Bharat initiative, with the objective of promoting patriotism, unity, and civic responsibility among youth.
