India-UAE emphasise restoring stability, supply chain continuity and deepening economic partnership

Union Minister of Commerce and Industry, Shri Piyush Goyal, had a virtual call with his UAE counterpart H.E. Dr. Thani bin Ahmed Al Zeyoudi.
