

Successful Conclusion of MY Bharat Budget Quest 2026

Enthusiastic Participation of Nearly 750 Youth Marks Mumbai Region Finale

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The Grand Finale of the MY Bharat Budget Quest 2026 (Mumbai Zone), organised by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports through the MY Bharat platform, concluded successfully at Dr. D.Y.
