During the visit, MoS Shri Jitin Prasada launched "SATYA AURA", which is a smart browser-based accessibility solution designed to make websites more accessible and user-friendly for everyone. The solution supports users with visual, cognitive, motor, auditory, neurological, and age-related accessibility needs, including senior citizens.

On this occasion, the Union Minister reviewed the ongoing research, technology development and innovation activities being undertaken by the organization in strategic and emerging sectors. The Minister was briefed on key research areas and indigenous technology development efforts aimed at strengthening India's scientific and technological capabilities.
