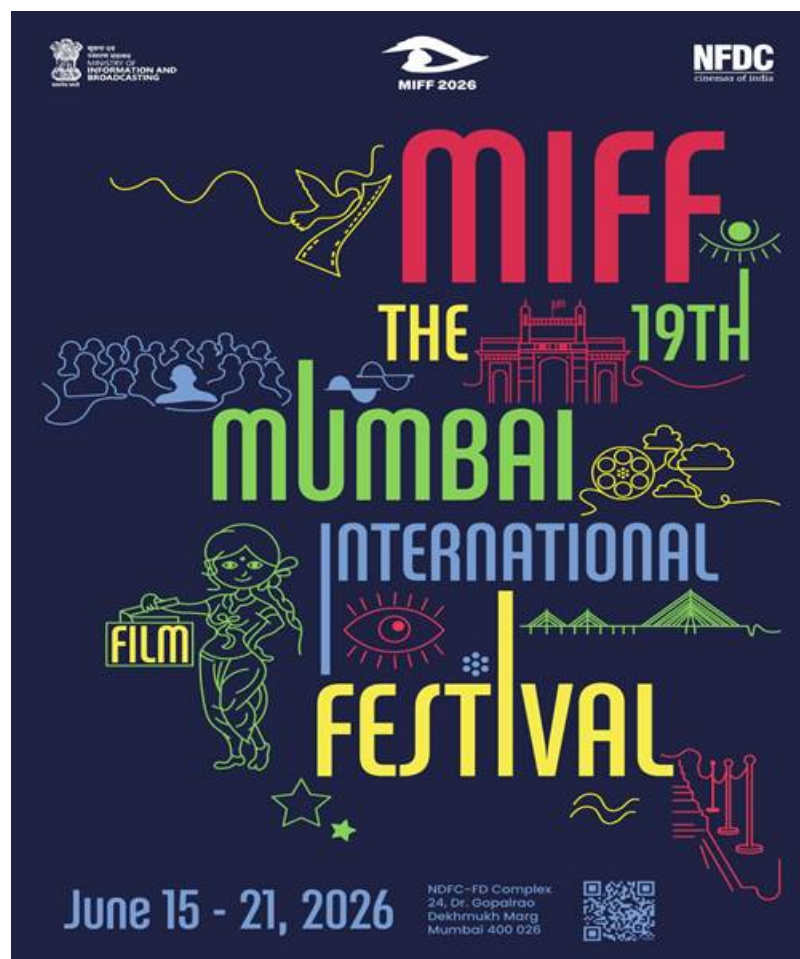
About 19th MIFF 2026
