The seven categories for the NAeG 2026, are (i) Government Process Re-engineering by Use of Technology for Digital Transformation, (ii) Innovation by Use of AI and Other New Age Technologies for Providing Citizen Centric Services, (iii) Best e-Gov Practices/Innovation in Cyber Security, (iv) District Level Initiatives in e-Governance, (v) Grassroots Level Initiatives by Gram Panchayats or equivalent

Traditional Local Bodies for Deepening/Widening of Service Delivery, (vi) Replication and Scaling of Nationally Awarded and Mission-Mode e-Governance Projects by States/UTs/Districts, (vii) Digital transformation by Use of Data Analytics in Digital Platforms by Central Ministries/States/UTs.

5. The NAeG Awards, 2026 consist of: (i) Trophy, (ii) Certificate and (iii) an incentive of Rs 10 lakh for Gold Awardees and Rs 5 lakh for Silver Awardees to be awarded to Central Ministry/Department/State/UT/ District/Organisation/Gram Panchayat for being utilised for implementation of project/programme or bridging resources gaps in any area of public welfare.
