

NSO to Organise Four-Day Regional Training Programme on AIDIS, SAS and Migration Survey in Nagpur

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The National Statistics Office (NSO), Regional Office Nagpur, under the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, Government of India, will organise a four-day regional training programme from June 16 to 19, 2026, at the MECL Training Centre, Nagpur. The programme will be conducted under the 81st Round of the National Sample Survey (NSS) and will cover the All-India Debt and Investment Survey (AIDIS), Situation Assessment Survey of Agricultural Households (SAS), and Migration Survey.

The training aims to strengthen the capacity of field officials by familiarising them with survey concepts, methodologies and operational procedures for the effective conduct of these surveys, scheduled from July 2026 to June 2027.

These surveys will generate important socio-economic data relating to household indebtedness and assets, the status of agricultural households, and migration patterns across the country, thereby supporting evidence-based policy formulation.

Around 100 officers and officials from NSO Regional Office Nagpur and the Coordination and Quality Control Division (CQCD), Nagpur, will participate in the programme. The training sessions will be conducted by experienced officers and subject experts from NSO and CQCD.

The programme will be inaugurated by Shri Srinivas Uppala, Deputy Director General, NSO (CQCD), West Zone, Nagpur, at 10:00 AM on June 16, 2026.

The initiative is expected to enhance the quality and reliability of data collection for these important national surveys.
