



Jan Aadhaar (Family ID) Now on DigiLocker: 7.5 Crore Rajasthan Citizens Get Instant Digital Access

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Around 7.5 crore residents of Rajasthan can now access their Jan Aadhaar (Family ID) on DigiLocker. India's flagship digital document wallet under the Digital India programme has on-boarded the credential issued by the Government of Rajasthan, so citizens can fetch and share it the moment it is needed.

The integration works in both directions. Citizens can pull their existing Jan Aadhaar (Family ID) into DigiLocker, and — because DigiLocker is also connected to Jan Aadhaar as a requestor — they can enrol for a new Family ID digitally and give consent from within the app.

Citizens can access their Jan Aadhaar (Family ID) on DigiLocker in four simple steps:

1. Open the DigiLocker app or visit digilocker.gov.in and sign in.
2. Search for “Jan Aadhaar” under Rajasthan State Government services.
3. Enter the required details and give consent.
4. Fetch the document — it is saved instantly to your DigiLocker account.

The Jan Aadhaar is Rajasthan's key household identity credential, widely used to avail government benefits and welfare schemes. On DigiLocker, citizens can retrieve and share it digitally whenever required, cutting reliance on physical cards and paperwork.

On DigiLocker, the Jan Aadhaar (Family ID) supports seamless access to services such as healthcare benefits under the Chiranjeevi Scheme, public distribution system (PDS) benefits, student scholarships and other welfare initiatives linked to the Jan Aadhaar ecosystem.

“Jan Aadhaar is the single key to dozens of welfare schemes in Rajasthan — putting it on DigiLocker means that key is always with the citizen,”
