

# Union Home Minister Amit Shah discusses Heavy Rain Situation with Maharashtra Chief Minister, assures all possible assistance

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Union Home Affairs and Cooperation Minister Shri Amit Shah spoke with Maharashtra Chief Minister Shri Devendra Fadnavis over telephone today, to review the situation caused by heavy rains in various parts of the state. Detailed discussions were held on the progress of relief and rescue operations in the affected areas, as well as the measures being taken to ensure the safety of citizens.

Union Minister Shri Amit Shah stated that the Central Government is closely monitoring the rainfall situation in Maharashtra and is in continuous contact with the state government.
