

NTPC hands over 19 Healthcare Vehicles to Government of Goa under CSR Initiative

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NTPC Limited, Western Region-I Headquarters, Mumbai, handed over 19 healthcare vehicles to the Directorate of Health Services, Government of Goa, under its Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiative to strengthen healthcare infrastructure and improve emergency medical services across the State.

The addition of these 19 healthcare vehicles will help strengthen emergency medical response, improve patient transportation services, and enhance the distribution of medicines across Goa, contributing to better and more accessible healthcare for the people of the State.





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
